

AIFD is marking its 67th years in India this year. In 1955, AIFD was founded with the Support of World Federation of the Deaf and First Generla Secretary Late Shri Bans Gopal Nigam.

The Federation has not prepared an annual report for the last 8 years. The Federation supported for the welfare of the communities in India for their needs.




20. WASLIA - WFDRSA MEET
