Health Minister late Shri Girin Choudhury was elected as Vice President of AAD while he was President of T.B. Hospital Society. He contributed a substantial plot of land admeasuring one Bigha 1(Katha) 19 (Nineteen) Lessa belonging to his society and was officially handed over to the Deaf Association.

Folk Art of Assam

There are many various evidences, both direct and indirect can be cited in support of the contention that Assam has had a rich and hoary tradition in the art of painting.

One of the oldest recorded evidences as to the existence of the practice of painting in ancient Assam is that of the inclusion, apart from various other things of artistic importance of painting, paraphernalia and painted articles "carved boxes of panels for painting with brushes and guards attached, and birds enclosed in gold painted bamboo cages"-among the gift presented by the Pragjyotisha King Kumara Bhaskara Varman to his friend and ally, Emperor Harsha Vardhana. Apart from this, direct references found in Harsa-carita of Banabhatta. Some indirect pointers as to the art of painting having been practiced in Assam during the rule of Varman dynasty are to be found. The Nidhanpur grant of Bhaskarvarman says that the king's portraits were seen in the palaces of his vassals; also the Uttarbil copper plate of Balavarman III contains a reference to a palace of the king which is saccitra, Le. containing pictures within. Again, from the exquisite workmanship of the stone doorframe found at Da- Parbatiya near Tezpur, which has been accepted as an outstanding example of the art of Gupta period, "It is developed in isolation. With the high development of architectural and sculptural arts, Assam must have developed its own style of painting too." Later some stone sculptures, some with folk characteristics are, however, clearly indicative of the prevalence of the corresponding folk painting style.

The description given by biographers of the painting of the scenes from the Seven Vaikunthas (heavens) on Tulapat (indigenously made paper) by the great medieval Assamese saint-artist Sankardeva (1449-1568), which formed the backdrop for the production of his first drama Cihnayatra, is another important evidence the merits according to which, the illustrious disciple of Sankardeva, while producing the play Govardhana-yatra, had mountain painted in the manner of Patuas. That incidentally, gives another relevant clue as to the antiquity of the art of painting in Assam. References Patuas (Painters of Patas or Pictures) are frequently met with in medieval Assamese literature, signifying the existing in those days of a class of professional painters and the expression "in the manner of the Patuas clearly indicates that the Patuas had a distinctive style of painting. The frequent occurrence of terms and ex- pressions like Citrakara (Painter), Pata/Citrapata (Painting) and Citrara Putala/Putali (a figure in a painting) in old Assamese literature would suggest that not only was the Assamese society in those days familiar with painting but the art of painting was fairly intimately connected with life in general. In Kamrupi dialect of Assamese language, there is an expression still current, which points to the practice of painting having been associated with another community. The natas are professional singers and dancers. The expression- Nata their Pat-means a painting belonging to the house of the natas.

Their works were non-elite, popular or folk nature, and that the available specimens of old painting with a folk character as well as the work of contemporary folk artists contain, elements that represent a continuation of the old tradition of the Patuas and the Natas.

The above evidences claim that the tradition of painting in Assum is consider ably old and it had at some time been quite widely popular.
